



## Primary PE and Sport Premium Plan for 2018/19

The Primary PE and Sport Premium was launched by the government in April 2013. It is ring-fenced funding to be used by the school to improve the quality and breadth of our PE, sport and physical activity provision.

The national vision is for: *“All pupils leaving primary school [to be] physically literate and with the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport.”*

In academic year 2018/19, we will receive approximately £19,520. Having consulted with pupils and parents, and to support our wider vision and plans for PE and sport, we plan to spend the Premium in the following ways.

Forest Schools staffing and training	£15,378	All children	All pupils in school have received active outdoor learning within the school grounds and beyond.  This has involved physical exercise as well as problem solving and thinking skills development. Pupil and parent voice has shown high levels of engagement and enjoyment in the process, contributing to emotional wellbeing.
Sports Apprentice post/ CPD	£6,309	All children	The recruitment of a dedicated and fully trained Sports Coach has impacted on the quality of teaching and learning significantly with children learning a greater range of skills and team games.  All adults supporting have taken CPD from the sessions and are able to deliver related teaching and learning.  A new and progressive curriculum which has been modified to suit the needs of the school and community is in place.
