



Primary PE and Sport Premium Plan for 2019-2020

The Primary PE and Sport Premium was launched by the government in April 2013. It is ring-fenced funding to be used by the school to improve the quality and breadth of our PE, sport and physical activity provision.

The national vision is for: *“All pupils leaving primary school [to be] physically literate and with the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport.”*

In academic year 2019/2020, we will receive approximately **£19,660**. In response to stakeholder feedback (pupils, parents, other adults in school), and to support our wider vision and plans for PE and sport, we plan to spend the Premium in the following ways:
