A contest was put on by the Queen, in spring. The snail and the dog with a tail, went to the start mark.



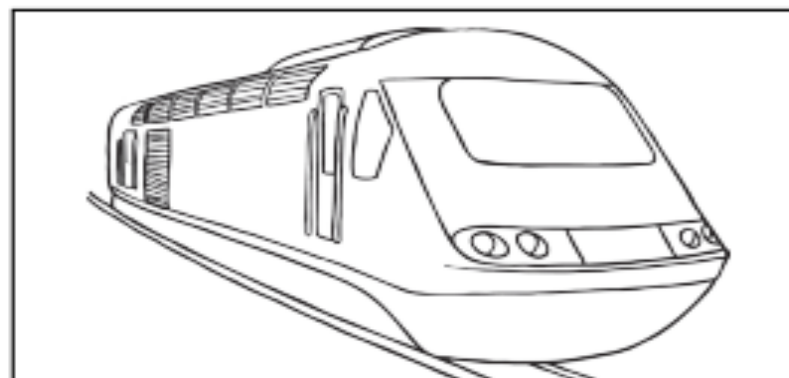
The aim was not to fail but to finish first. The main road was straight but full of bumps.
