When you see **ore** in a word, it always makes the /or/ sound. The **e** is silent. Let's say these examples:

more

score

Practise reading words

ore Board Game

Start 

Finish 

score, shore, snore, chore, more, snore, tore, score, chore, core

shore, snore, chore, core, score, snore, more, shore

Move back two spaces.

Move forward two spaces.

Let's practise writing some words that contain **ore** saying /or/ sound. Read- cover- write

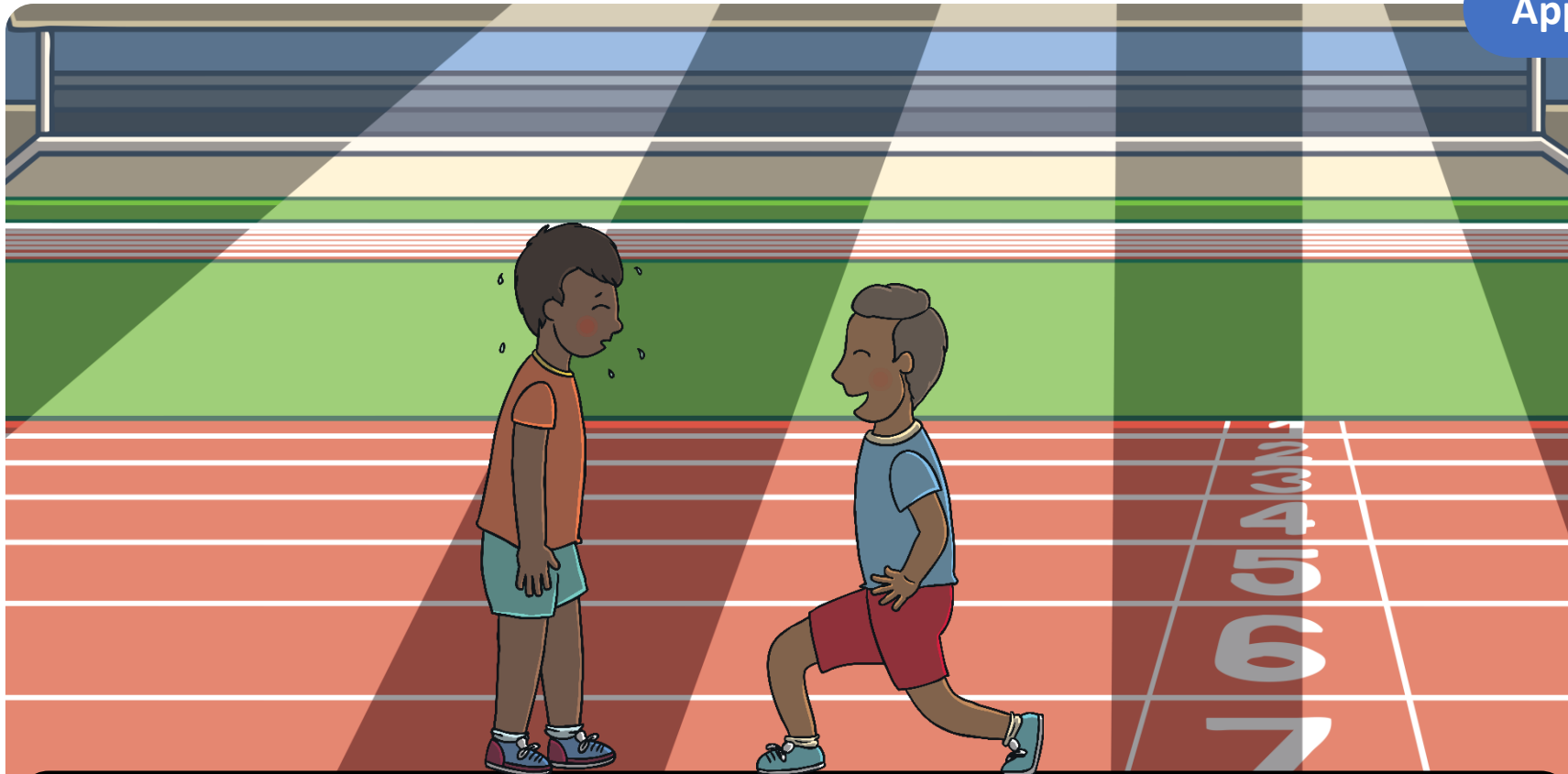
