**History 3-** Complete the 'how you are feeling' worksheet and think about three things you're grateful for.

Now can you have a go at interviewing your family members and record their answers? Use the provided worksheet to help you.

**History 4-** Complete the 'my community' worksheet and then have a go at writing a letter to yourself. As you will be able to look back and remember all the amazing things that you did- You could even use your imagination and create your own!

**History 5-** Use the mind map worksheet to help you think about what you are doing while you're at home and keeping safe.

Finally, to finish off your time capsule you could print all the hands of the people who are keeping safe with you.

Remember: You don't have to use the exact worksheets, they are there to help you come up with exciting ideas. Can you be more imaginative and create your own?
